Stalls Reservations and Assignments: Stalls are first come, first serve, and can be purchased online at sherrycervi.com. Additional stalls, RVs and Shavings can be purchased online until 1/10/24, and then onsite at the office, depending on availability. If you are going to be arriving outside normal check-in hours, please text 520-907-9549 and make arrangements prior to arrival. The Pima Country Fairgrounds is a complete facility offering lots of amenities. All Stalls are fully covered and enclosed. To **reserve your stall**(s), you will need to buy online prior to January 10, 2024.

Note that horses are not allowed to be tied overnight and must be in stalls. 1 bag of shavings is required and is included in the fee. (Per Pima County Fairgrounds Rules & Regulations) Outside shavings are not allowed! All stalls will be preassigned prior to arrival and pre-purchased Shavings will be in your stalls. No overnight tying to trailer or setting up of portable panels. No EXCEPTIONS!

RV Spots/Hook Ups: There should be plenty of RV hook-ups, but we recommend you reserve one prior to arrival. RV Spots are available online at www.sherrycervi.com. Again, if you are arriving after hours, please let them know prior to arrival. If you are "dry camping", staying in your trailer or camping with no hook-up, there is a one-time \$30 dry fee.

Coggins & Health Certificates: The state of Arizona requires a Health Certificate within 30 days of coming across state lines. Annual Coggins is required by all states. Always be prepared to show papers at any time while on the premises. If you are unsure if you need health papers depending on where you live or where you are traveling, ask your veterinarian.

Food: Pima County Fairgrounds has a concession, and their Cantina serving breakfast, lunch and dinner. There is also other food trucks present for the event.

Showers: Pima County Fairgrounds has bathrooms and great showers located in the main arena building.

Feed & Tack Store: Steer Crazy Tack Trailer will be set up with a full tack offering and Martin saddles. Shavings and hay are available to purchase at the show office.

Veterinarian & Farrier: We will do our best to have a veterinarian and farrier onsite, but not guaranteed.

Arena Set Up & Warm-up: The competition arena will feature a holding pen and closed gate. Riders MUST be in the holding pen the drag before their run! Weather permitting; there will be an outside warm-up area and covered warm-up area accessible to all contestants.

Exhibitions / Time Only's: Time-Onlys will be available for purchase all day Thursday before the race. (exhibition schedule subject to change). Riders will be allowed 60 seconds and one time through the pattern only. Check SCYC facebook page for official times.

Drags: Small Drags will occur every 5 riders, and big drags will take place every 50 riders.
