Stalls Reservations and Assignments: Stalls are purchased online at sherrycervi.com. Shavings are available to purchase online 6/24 – 7/15/26. During the event, shavings can be purchased from G3 Supply onsite between 8AM – 6PM ONLY. Shavings will not be available outside of those hours, so please plan ahead. If you will arrive outside of normal check-in hours, please TEXT TBA prior to the event. We will do our best to accommodate stalling by your friends and family, but only if requests are made as soon as possible. We cannot accept requests the week of the event.

The Garwood Arena is a fantastic facility with many amenities. All stalls are fully covered and enclosed. Stalls are mandatory for every horse entered. No horses can be tied in the parking lot for any amount of time, they must be stalled.

1 bag of shavings is included in your weekend stall package. Outside shavings are not allowed per Garwood Arena rules! All stalls will be pre-assigned prior to arrival and pre-purchased shavings will be in your stalls.

To ensure your stalls and/or RVs are with your friends or family, we recommend ONE person enter all contestants with stalls and RVs under a single login. YOU DO NOT NEED MULTIPLE LOGINS TO ENTER DIFFERENT CONTESTANTS. USE ONE (1) EMAIL AND PASSWORD FOR EVERYTHING.

RV Spots/Hook Ups: There should be plenty of RV hook-ups, but we recommend you purchase one online at www.sherrycervi.com when entries open. We will do our best to accommodate parking by your friends and family, but only if requests are made as soon as possible. We cannot accept requests the week of the event. Again, if you are arriving after hours, please text the number above prior to arrival. Use of the Dump Station is included when you purchase an RV event package.

There is NO tying horses at trailers in RV spots, or anywhere on gravel, or grass. Zero tolerance for tying horses to trailers, for any amount of time. All Youth Race contestants must purchase a stall. If you are driving in and out, for 1 day only, you must park in a designated areas as marked. There is a daily stall fee if you are only coming only to either the Friday warm-up race or Saturday pee-wee class. **No overnight tying to trailer or setting up of portable panels. No EXCEPTIONS!**

Coggins & Health Certificates: The state of Ohio requires a Health Certificate within 30 days of crossing state lines, but this requirement is subject to change. Please refer to the current Ohio state for current guidelines and requirements, and ask your veterinarian if you have any questions. Parents or individual contestants are responsible for knowing what the current requirements are for the state/s you are traveling. Annual Coggins is required.

Tack, Clothing, and Shavings Store: G3 Supply is fully stocked!

Restaurant and Bar: The Garwood Grill and the new Bucking Goat Saloon will be open. No outside alcohol allowed.

Veterinarian & Farrier: We will do our best to have a veterinarian and farrier onsite, but not guaranteed.

Arena Set Up & Warm-up: The competition arena will feature a holding pen and closed gate. Riders **MUST** be in the holding pen the drag before their run. There will be designated warm-up areas accessible to all contestants.

Exhibitions / Time Only's: Time-Onlys will be available for purchase Wednesday and Thursday before the race (exhibition schedule subject to change). Riders will be allowed 60 seconds and one time through the pattern only. Check the Facebook page and event schedule for times.

Drags: Small Drags will occur every 5 riders, and big drags will take place every 50 riders.

Scooters, Segways, Bikes, Skateboards, or ANYTHING you ride on with wheels is not allowed in any buildings or stall barns. Garwood Arena posts a strict, no-exception policy for the horses' and everyone's safety. Breaking this ground rule could result in disqualification from the event.
